It was advised that the CISCO is an information/social centre and not an evacuation point (unless declared by Department of Communities). The CISCO would not be kept open in hazardous circumstances. W.Trow advised that the trees have been brought to the attention of the Shire previously.	Information		
	Council meeting dates. Council has released its dates for Council meetings in 2024. All will be held in Donnybrook because the live streaming facility is only available at Council Chambers. Live streaming accumulates around 200 views per meeting. In the past, one meeting per year has been held in Yabberup, Kirup and Balingup; with Balingup attracting 21 locals to the 2022 meeting. Although Balingup has good attendance, no community members attended Yabberup/Kirup. Councillors therefore voted unanimously to hold all meetings in Donnybrook.			
	The Shire recommends BPA contact local Councillors if we are not happy with this decision. The meeting felt strongly that Balingup should have at least one meeting in Balingup per year and queried the difficulty of accessing equipment needed for live streaming. **Brockman Street Land Acquisition**. On 1 Nov 23, a meeting was held between representatives of BPA, BMC, Bibbulmun Track, Shire and Talison to discuss possible ways to address two issues:

- Balingup Carnivale needs more space to expand, and
- There is a shortage of low cost accommodation in town causing a particular problem for Bibbulmun Track walkers.

We discussed the possible purchase of 53 Brockman St however this would take 3 -5 years and require approval from the Department of Health. We asked Talison if this could be considered under their community grants scheme but they have advised it would probably not be within the scope of Talison grants.

The Shire suggested two alternatives:

- BMC to expand the event into the carpark and land between the
  existing site and Station Master's House (to be done during the Event
  Application process), and
- Shire would identify land suitable for the development of short term (Shire Owned) accommodation.

The Shire has since provided options at adjacent to Balingup Recreation Centre.

Talison has advised that they would consider giving a grant to purchase transportable style accommodation on Shire owned land – application to be submitted by the Shire. Talison suggested that it be owned by Shire but run by BPA – with BPA as beneficiaries of the income.

S.Franks also raised an idea of putting a small walkers hut (prefab building with shower) near the Community Centre toilets. For Carnivale and walkers. She advised that the Shire say they would consider this idea.

T.Larkin advised he has spoken to the Post Office to see if the community could support their efforts to re-open the backpackers accommodation but they say this is not an option in the short term. 4-6 people end to ender walkers come through Balingup on an average a day – more during peak season.

It was agreed that BPA would have no objections to use land near community centre.
