## **HOW IS IT DECIDED?**

Grants applications are assessed by the BPA Trust Fund Committee. The Committee is comprised of 5 members including the BPA President, the BPA Treasurer and 1 member each from the Small Farm Field Day Committee, the Medieval Carnivale Committee and the BalingUpcycle Committee. Committee members will act in a manner consistent with the agreed code of conduct.

All applications will be rated according to the same criteria including the benefit to the Balingup and/or Mullalyup communities, the likelihood of success, sustainability and availability of other funding sources.

Decisions made by the BPA Trust Fund Committee will be agreed by majority (not consensus). The decisions made by the committee are final and there is no appeal process.

### WHO CAN APPLY?

Not for profit community groups from Balingup and Mullalyup are eligible to apply for community grants from the Balingup Progress Assocation Trust Fund.

#### **GUIDELINES FOR APPLICANTS**

- Grants need to be for a specific purpose.
- Quotes and budgets are to be submitted where possible.
- Grants may be awarded for less than the total amount requested.
- Funds are expected to be spent within 12 months of allocation.
- No application will be considered after the due date.
- Funding will not be granted for personal gain or structural changes to Government or Shire buildings.
- It is recommended that individual applications are backed by a Committee.
